We are so grateful for another year at the Look Up Center. It's hard to believe 2022 is ending and we will soon be headed for a New Year! We are encouraged as we look forward to what the Lord has planned for HIS Center in 2023.

This year has been a year of change at the Look Up Center. We are so thankful to have met our \$500K building fundraising goal. With these funds we were able to replace our HVAC system in the 110-year-old building, change all existing lighting to LED, add an addition onto our pole building, expand our trades program, add an ADA restroom, create space for our new "day program"-Glory Rising, remodel our

Opportunity Store, add 8,000 square feet of new flooring, and some fresh paint. All of this required multiple moves and a lot of flexibility from our staff and volunteers. All donors and in-kind donors are listed in this issue of our newsletter. Thank you to our community for your support of our mission.

We are very excited to announce that our Dental Clinic recently celebrated 11 years of serving our community. In those 11 years we have provided over \$1M in free emergency dental care to those without insurance. Licking Memorial Health Systems provided the funding for our new DIGITAL DENTAL X-RAY equipment! We hope to be fully digital by January, 2023! Thank you also to the Licking County Foundation for funding additional needs to support the equipment such as laptops, software, electrical wiring, programming, etc. We are grateful for staff and volunteers that keep our clinic operational!

We are currently preparing for our Annual Thanksgiving meal delivery on Thanksgiving morning. We will be delivering meals to those in our community without transportation, those who are ill, or don't have family. Last year we delivered over 1,000 meals and we anticipate the need to be 1,000 plus this year. If you are looking for a way to get involved this is a great outreach opportunity. If you know someone who needs a meal delivered, please give us a call and we will add them to our list.

Our second annual O'Holy Night 5K Pet Friendly Fun Run/Walk to support the Look Up Center is set for Sunday, December 4th. All funds raised stay local and serve residents of Licking County. I hope you will consider joining us for an evening of sharing the true meaning of Christmas with our participants in a unique 5K experience.

In 2021 our Christmas Pop Up shop helped 252 children receive Christmas gifts, stockings, coats, hats, and PJ's. We are collecting new and gently used toys, games, puzzles, STEM items, sports items, bath & body items, and gift cards for children ages 0-17.
