INTRODUCING LOOK UP LIFT

Our new "Pilot" transportation services will provide rides to "referred" individuals to destinations within a 10-mile radius of Look Up Center.

This includes the following areas: • Hebron • Heath • St. Louisville • Granville • Marne • Hanover • Newark

Schedule: Monday-Friday Transportation will be provided Monday-Friday – hours TBD. Individuals must be referred by a non-profit, church, caseworker, court service, or other as determined. Once a referral is made transportation will be provided to individuals for the following purposes:

- Work/job
- Housing appointments
- Miscellaneous appointments (non-medical)
 - Court ordered meetings/appointments

Fees: Agencies/organizations with an established budget for transportation will pay based on the current approved transportation fee schedule. The Look Up Center will not charge a fee for services to individuals or organizations without means to pay for transportation, however, donations are appreciated and will help to offset the cost of the program. No one will be denied services due to an inability to donate.

NOTE: It's important to know that this is NOT a public transportation program but rather an opportunity to assist individuals without transportation to get to work and required appointments. This is a "Pilot" program that we plan to implement June 1, 2023. Drivers are volunteers and the program is funded by Look Up Center supporters.
