## "The Suffering Child of God" Romans 8:16-18 & Romans 8:1 & 30

"In my pursuit of holiness it is guaranteed that I will suffer physically and emotionally and flourish spiritually and eternally. The pursuit of holiness is putting myself at risk."

- "The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God...."
  - God shows His love towards us in that we are called His children (1 John 3:1). As His children we walk in righteousness (1 John 3:7-10); As His children we love in deed and truth (1 John 3:16-18); As His children we love our brothers and sisters (1 John 5:1-3) and we keep ourselves free from idols (1 John 5:21).
- "The Spirit Himself bears witness that we are heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ...."
  - God has qualified us to be heirs with Christ (Colossians 1:12); We went from inheriting death to inheriting life (Colossians 1:13-14); We went from being slaves to death to being fellow sons of God and heirs with Christ (Galatians 4:7); God is the source of our inheritance (Colossians 3:24) and He is our inheritance (1 Peter 3:18; Psalm 73:25-26) and our inheritance is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading (1 Peter 1:4).
  - O What do we share with Christ?
    - We will share in His victory (Revelation 3:21); We will share in His glory (John 17:22); We will share in His riches (2 Corinthians 8:9); We will bear His image (1 Corinthians 15:49); We will share with Him in the enjoyment of all things (Hebrews 1:2).
- "Provided we suffer with Him....we will be glorified with Him...."
  - Our Justification is a guarantee, our Glorification is a guarantee, and our suffering (Sanctification) is a guarantee (Romans 8:30).
  - We are promised that we will suffer in this life (2 Timothy 3:12; 1 Peter 2:19-24; 1 Peter 5:9-10; Matthew 5:10-12) and that the sufferings are not worth comparing to the glory that will be revealed to us (2 Corinthians 4:16-17; 1 Peter 4:12-19).
  - "Christlike love seeks its happiness in the happiness of others not at their expense. It will even suffer and die for the beloved in order that its joy may be made full in the life and purity of the beloved." (John Piper)
    - John 15:12-13: The greatest expression of love is to lay down one's life for his friends. In obeying God's Word, we express our love by laying down our control and comforts (suffering).
    - Ephesians 5:25-30: In giving up our comfort and control (suffering) we show our desire to see others sanctified and we love ourselves by doing this because we are of the same body.
    - Colossians 1:24-29: The greatest act of love and suffering will be seen in desiring to see all people come to know Christ and grow in maturity in Christ.
    - Hebrews 12:5-6: Because God loves us we will also suffer in discipline as He sanctifies His children.
