"Can Anything or Anyone Cause Us to Lose Our Salvation?" (Part 1)

Romans 8:31-39

- What is "eternal security"?
 - It is the belief that a Christian cannot lose their salvation. If they are truly in Christ they will persevere to the end.
- "If God is for us, who can be against us?"
 - Christ died: We have all sinned against God and deserve to receive the righteous wrath of God as punishment for our sins (Romans 3:23-26; Romans 5:8-10) because the wages of sin is physical and eternal death (Romans 6:20-23; Genesis 2:16-17). Christ died for our sins that He would receive our punishment and we would receive His grace and righteousness (2 Corinthians 5:20-21; Isaiah 53:10-12).
 - Christ was raised from the dead: If Christ was not raised we are still dead in our sins (1 Corinthians 15:17) and all faith and preaching is in vain (1 Corinthians 15:14). Christ's resurrection lets us know that He was victorious over death, the Devil, and Hell (1 Corinthians 15:55-56; Hebrews 2:14-15), that His perfect sacrifice was accepted by God the Father (Hebrews 10:10-12; Acts 13:36-39), and that we will receive resurrected, glorified bodies, just like Christ (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; 1 Corinthians 15:50-54).
 - Christ sits at the right hand of God: Christ sitting at the right hand of God shows His deity (John 1:1-5) and it shows that He has equal authority, honor, and glory as God the Father (Ephesians 1:19-22; Philippians 2:5-10). The evidence that Christ is sitting victorious (Hebrews 1:3-4) at the right hand of God is that we have received the Holy Spirit (John 16:5-13).
 - Christ is interceding for us: Christ's work not only saved us, but continually secures us (Hebrews 7:25). Christ has reconciled us to God and continues to sustain that reconciliation (Romans 5:10-11). Christ is our Advocate before the Father and proclaims our innocence because we are covered in His righteousness (1 John 2:1). He is our mediator (1 Timothy 2:5) and because of Him we have access to the Father in prayer (Hebrews 4:14-16).
