"Is There Injustice on God's Part? (Part 1)" Romans 9:13-18

"Sovereignty is God's right and power to do all that He pleases. Providence is God using His sovereignty to bring about an ultimate purpose for the universe that cannot fail. The nature of God's providence does not take away man's will. His providence is formed by His wisdom, justice, and mercy." (John Piper)

- There are two groups of people in the context of salvation. It is by our choosing and God's choosing that we are in one of these two groups (Romans 10:13; John 3:16; 1 Corinthians 1:23-24).
 - Those loved by God and love God: Experience no condemnation; Have been given the Holy Spirit; Put to death their sin by the Holy Spirit; Are adopted sons and daughters; Are heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ; Are helped by the Holy Spirit; Will receive glorified bodies; Have all things work together for them; Have God for them; Have been graciously given all things to persevere in their salvation; Have Christ and the Holy Spirit interceding for them; Cannot be separated from the love of Christ; Are more than conquerors (Romans 8:1-39).
 - Those hated by God and hate God: They are under eternal condemnation; They are slaves to sin; They are under His wrath; They are hostile towards God; They cannot please God; They do not submit to God; God is against them; They are separated from Christ's love; They store up wrath for themselves; They suppress the truth; They do not honor God or give thanks to Him.
- The sinner is hated by God (salvation) and loved by God (common grace). God hates both the sin and the sinner.
 - The Psalmist's testimony about God hating the sinner: Psalm 2:4-5 & 9-12; Psalm 5:4-6;
 Psalm 7:11-13; Psalm 11:4-7.
 - John's testimony about God's wrath towards the sinner: Revelation 6:12-16; Revelation 14:9-11; Revelation 16:4-11.
 - God takes no delight in the punishment of the wicked, but does take delight in His justice: Ezekiel 18:30-32; Ezekiel 33:10-11; Matthew 23:37-38.
 - God hates sin: Deuteronomy 12:31; Deuteronomy 16:21-17:1; Proverbs 6:16-19;
 Proverbs 8:13; Psalm 45:7; Isaiah 1:14.
 - As Christians we are called to love those outside of Christ: Matthew 5:43-48.
