"Ecclesiology: The Doctrine of the Church:
"Discipleship: Making Disciples is Gloriously Hard!"
2 Timothy 2:1-7; Exodus 20:3; Luke 14:33; Matthew 28:18-20

"We enjoy Christ to the utmost in this life by making disciples (1 Thessalonians 2:19-20 & 3:8-10; 3 John 1:4).

Discipleship is the expression of our joy in Him."

"If the goal and the joy of the christian life is to glorify God and hallow His Name by making disciples, then we should live this out to our fullest capacity so that no one on the planet would think that being a Christian is anything less. And when we don't, thank God for His grace, and get back to work."

- What is a Disciple/Christian (Acts 11:26) in the most basic sense?
  - o It is a person who has been saved (Romans 10:9-13); It is a person who desires to be taught the Word of God so that they know how to think, act, and feel as a Christian (Romans 6:3-14); It is a person who desires to help others grow in these areas (Ephesians 4:11-16); It is a person that desires for others to be saved (1 Corinthians 10:31-33).
    - Every Christian should be helping unbelievers become believers by showing them Christ, in word and deed.
    - Every Christian should be helping other believers grow more and more in maturity.
    - Every Christian should be seeking to get help for themselves from others to keep growing.
- It will cost us greatly to make disciples (2 Timothy 2:1-7):
  - o It will cause suffering. We will be hurt and disappointed in making disciples (2:3).
  - We will have to give up worldly pursuits (2:4).
  - We will have to give up pleasing people for pleasing God (2:4).
  - Obedience is hard but it has a greater reward than the fleeting pleasures of sin (2:5).
  - o It is hard work like farming, you can't be lazy (2:6).
  - It is going to require great patience (2:6).
- What are the means of "making disciples"?
  - It is valuing Jesus above all other things in this world (Mark 8:34-37).
  - When I am a hearer and doer of the Word (James 1:22 & 2:14).
  - Celebrating when others are walking in obedience to God's Word (1 John 1:4; 2 John 1:4; 3 John 1:4).
  - Love one another according to God's Word (John 13:34-35; 1 John 5:2-3).
  - Dealing with sin properly by putting it to death and reconciling with one another (Romans 8:12-13; Matthew 18:15).
  - Thinking of others more highly than ourselves (Philippians 2:3-4; Ephesians 5:25).
  - Loving your spouse and children biblically (Ephesians 5:22-6:4).
  - Encouraging one another (Hebrews 3:13; 1 Thessalonians 5:11).
  - Use the gifts that God has given you to serve one another (1 Peter 4:10).
  - Help others grow in their understanding of scriptures (Acts 18:24-26; Romans 15:14).
  - Value Biblical preaching (2 Timothy 4:1-2).
  - Submit to and imitate Biblical leadership (Hebrews 13:7 & 17).
  - o Going to church to stir up one another to love and good works (Hebrews 10:23-24).

- What is cultural "Christianity"?
  - I affirm that the most important attribute of God is love. Tolerance and acceptance of all behaviors is the definition of love. Unless you disagree.
