"God the great Creator of all things doth uphold, direct, dispose, and govern (He cares for, sustains, and superintends) all creatures, actions, and things, from the greatest to the least...to the praise of the glory of His wisdom, power, justice, goodness, and mercy."

(The Westminster Confession of Faith)

Sovereignty: God's right and power to do all that He wills.

*Providence:* God seeing to it that things happen in a certain way for a specific purpose.

- God made the earth, owns the earth, and does as He pleases with it (Isaiah 45:12; Psalm 24:1; Psalm 115:1-3).
  - God reigns over all earthquakes and volcanic eruptions (Psalm 60:2; Psalm 104:32). God reigns over all tidal waves and hurricanes and storms and rain (Matthew 8:27; Psalm 89:8-9; Deuteronomy 28:12). God reigns over freezing rain and snow and even water freezing over (Job 37:10-14; Psalm 105:32; Psalm 147:16-17). God reigns over famine and drought (Isaiah 5:6; Amos 4:7 & 10). Nothing is random or caused by "mother nature" (Romans 11:36).
  - o God reigns over the seas dividing (Nehemiah 9:11) and walking on water (Matthew 14:25).
  - God reigns over all plant life (Psalm 104:14; Ezekiel 36:29) and God reigns over all animals (Matthew 6:26; Jonah 1:17; John 21:5-6; Psalm 147:8-9; Psalm 104:27-29).
- God is sovereign over Satan and Demons.
  - God commands demons and Satan and they can do nothing without permission from God
     (Matthew 8:28-32; Mark 1:27; Luke 22:31-32; Job 1:8-12; Job 2:4-7).
  - God uses Satan, sickness, and hardships of all kinds for the good suffering of His people that will make them see, savor, and be conformed into Christ-likeness (1 Peter 3:17; 1 Peter 4:19; 1 Peter 2:19-21; Revelation 2:10; 1 Peter 5:6-10; Deuteronomy 32:39).
  - Job would not give Satan sovereignty over anything (Job 1:21 & Job 2:10).
    - The Sabeans, fire from heaven, the Chaldeans, a great wind, and Job's sickness are all under the idea of "The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away." God is sovereign over all of these events coming to pass.

"Satan is real and terrible. All his designs are hateful. But he is not sovereign. Whatever Satan does God governs it according to His all-wise providence."

- God is sovereign over life and death (James 4:15; Hebrews 9:27; Job 14:5; Deuteronomy 32:39).
  - God at times takes life for the judgment of sin: Eli's sons (1 Samuel 2:25), Nabal (1 Samuel 25:38), Uzzah (2 Samuel 6:7), Annanias & Sapphira (Acts 5:1-11), Herod (Acts 12:23), and taking the Lord's supper in an unworthy manner (1 Corinthians 11:30).
  - The Lord also is sovereign over martyr's losing their lives for the gospel (John 21:18-19;
     Revelation 6:9-11). Every breath is under the sovereignty of God (Acts 17:25; Daniel 5:23;
     Isaiah 42:5; Job 12:10).
    - Is fate in control of life and death, is Satan, is man, or is God?
