"What Is Christian Freedom?" (Part 3) — I Live By faith In The Son Of God Galatians 2:15-21 (v.20)

Those whom God effectually calleth, He also freely justifieth, not by infusing righteousness into them, but by pardoning their sins, and by accounting and accepting their persons as righteous; not for anything wrought in them, or done by them, but for Christ's sake aloneFaith, thus receiving and resting on Christ and His righteousness, is the only instrument of justification. Yet it [faith] is not alone in the person justified, but is ever accompanied with all other saving graces and is not dead faith, but worketh by love. (Westminster Confession)

- An Overview of the text:
 - Whether you are a Jew or a Gentile "sinner" the only way to have right standing with God is by faith in Jesus Christ (Galatians 3:26-27). The purpose of the law was to make us aware of our need for a Savior, not to be our savior. *"For by works of the law no human being will be justified in His sight, since through the law comes knowledge of sin." (Romans 3:20)*
 - If we are saved by the keeping of the law, then Christ is a servant of sin because He lied about the means of salvation (John 3:16). If we are saved by keeping the law then Paul and the Apostles are ministers of sin by preaching grace (Galatians 2:18-19). If we are saved by keeping the law, we don't need grace and Christ died for no reason (Galatians 2:21).
- Galatians 2:20:
 - What does it mean to be crucified with Christ? (Romans 6:1-14)
 - 1) My old self was crucified with Christ, I am united with Him, I am identified by Him by walking in "a newness of life" (Romans 6:1-6). 2) I am no longer a slave to sin's power and consequences (Romans 6:6-7). 3) I am not under the power of the Law, I'm under the power of grace (Romans 6:14).
 "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." (2 Corinthians 5:17)
 - What does it mean that as a Christian Christ lives in me? (Romans 6:1-13; 8:1-17)
 - 1) I am free from the law of sin and death, it has no dominion over me. I am no longer a slave to sin. There is no condemnation (Romans 6:17; 8:1-3). 2) I now belong to Christ and joyfully submit to His will (Romans 8:4,9,12-13). 3) The Holy Spirit lives in me and is the source of my new thinking and acting (Romans 8:6,10-11). 4) I have been set free from living for myself, which is death...."and He died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for Him who for their sake died and was raised." (2 Corinthians 5:15)
 - \circ $\;$ What does it mean to live by faith in the Son of God?
 - 1) It means that the Christian life from beginning to end is choosing to believe God over and over again (Romans 1:17). 2) Saving faith is a faith that shows itself by obedience to God, or that faith is action (James 2:17-19). 3) Saving faith leads to a life that pleases God (Hebrews 11:6). 4) I'm free from having to trust or have faith in myself. God has given me His Word (Psalm 119:105), His Spirit (Romans 8:14), Elders (1 Peter 5:1-5), and brothers and sisters in Christ (Titus 2:1-10), to help guide me in obedience to Him.
 - How amazing is it that Christ loved me and gave Himself for me?
 - "But God shows His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Since, therefore, we now have been justified by His blood, much more shall we be saved by Him from the wrath of God" (Romans 5:8-9). "In this is love, not that we have loved God but that He loved us and sent His Son to

 be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another" (1 John 4:10-11). "But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ — by grace you have been saved" (Ephesians 2:4-5).

- Closing thoughts:
 - Striving for holiness, without joy flowing from God's love towards us creates *LEGALISTS*. Striving to have joy flowing from God's love without holiness will create *LIBERTINES*. *CHRISTIANITY* is striving for holiness with a joy that flows from God's love, for God's glory. We need to, by faith, believe in a joyful pursuit of Christlikeness because it was the JOY set before Christ that gave us the offer of salvation (Hebrews 12:2). It is our JOY to receive salvation (Romans 5:1-2, 11), and it is Christ's JOY in us that grows us in salvation (John 15:1-11).
