## "What Is Spiritual Warfare?: Does It Really Matter?" Ephesians 6:10-13

"Spiritual warfare (the battle to operate in reality) is the responsibility of every Christian to <u>fight</u> <u>valiantly</u> for Christ to be hallowed, treasured, glorified, revered, prioritized, obeyed, loved, and viewed as sufficient for all things, through the salvation of the lost, the sanctification of the saints, the public and private worship of His children, and His people joyfully identifying with Christ in the sufferings and the blessings of this life." (Matthew 10:37-39)

"Satan, our flesh, and this world <u>fight relentlessly</u> that every Christian would be uninterested or be minimalistic for Christ to be hallowed, treasured, glorified, revered, prioritized, obeyed, loved, and viewed as sufficient in all things, through focusing on the sins and failures or accomplishments of ourselves or others, desiring to be loved by the world and God, busying people by a focus on the cares of life or accolades in this life, or believing lies and false doctrines, that lead to a lack of interest in the salvation of the lost, the sanctification of the saints, the public and private worship of God, and identifying with Christ in the sufferings and blessings of this life." (1 Peter 5:8-9; cf. Luke 22:31-34)

- Ephesians 6:10-13:
  - "Be strong in the Lord": My fighting valiantly is totally dependent on my humble admittance of my weakness and my proclamation of His strength. "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you." (James 4:7) My resistance is dependent on my submitting.
  - "Put on the whole armor of God": Spiritual warfare is "all in". I must put on the whole armor or I'm susceptible to attack, leading to uninterest and a minimalistic Christianity. "and He died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for Him who for their sake died and was raised." (2 Corinthians 5:15; cf. Galatians 2:20) I live for the will of God, and His will is that His Name would be hallowed (Matthew 6:9-10).
  - "The schemes of the devil": He is a liar, he is the father of lies, so we should expect an attack of lies (John 8:44). He loves to accuse believers as unworthy of salvation and deceive them, leading to doubts and a lack of confidence in our salvation (Revelation 12:9-11). He wants us to be full of anxiety in suffering or possible suffering in this life (1 Peter 5:6-11). He wants to deceive us by burdening us or "freeing us" with unbiblical doctrines (1 Timothy 4:1-4). He wants us to keep back forgiveness and love towards our brothers and sisters in Christ (2 Corinthians 2:7-11). He wants us to doubt the importance or legitimacy of certain portions of Scripture or hold the wisdom of this world supreme over the Word of God (2 Corinthians 10:2-6).
  - "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against...": We are source-centric people. The source of our frustrations are not flesh and blood, ultimately, and the source of our strength is not flesh and blood, ultimately. Our job is to appeal to *The* source for strength and to attack the source in our warfare. The fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-26) is the way we deal with flesh and blood and Spiritual Warfare is the way we deal with our enemies (Ephesians 6:13-20). Friendly fire is never acceptable in spiritual warfare.
